# 1. Meeting called to order at 5:30 PM

- Motion to approve 19<sup>th</sup> meeting minutes (May 19, 2025). All in favor.
- Kudos to all for contributing to success of Visioning Workshop
- Group voted approval of reimbursement for Visioning Workshop expenses of \$140.71

# 2. <u>Discussion about the Visioning Workshop</u>

- Draft report from Ann with Wally edits
- Intent to post to website, send to all attendees
- Need for small group chairs to review by end of week
- Matt Stanley: positive comments received re workshop from various participants
- Big takeaway wasn't 'alternative visions' (re paper 'thinking beyond')
- Overarching goals was big takeaway from workshop:
- -- Managing Growth; Enhancing Quality of Life; Creating Opportunity; Leveraging Resources
- -- challenge of how to accomplish these goals remains; how terms are interpreted
- -- degree of consensus was exceptional but need to watch for bias in who participated in survey and workshop, college educated older residents; need to keep reaching out
- discussion: result was enabled by participatory engagement; not a forced result
- -- no enthusiasm in land use group for alternatives such as zoning (Matt G)
- -- concerns and alternatives varied in different parts of town (e.g., what infrastructure enables), in-fill opportunities only if local owners are supportive (Matt S)
  - -- some in-fill ongoing; maybe more of this if lot prices continue to increase (Tim R)
- -- our plan may have to suggest different preferences by different segments of the town in what can be accomplished (Wally W)
- -- in-fill, zoning, water/sewer capacity are specific issues for local discussion, portrayal in plan, trying to identify places where people want growth, and then talk how (Ann RH)

### 3. Comprehensive Survey #2 discussion

- what are the most essential questions for us to ask (re memo 'question list')?

- -- need to thin out what we do want to get this summer
- -- at independence day/jay day even fewer questions to lead discussion
- -- intriguing to have a topical section such as housing
- -- seeking feedback
- like have some specific topics on things like housing, families, trade-off growth & taxes
- specific changes such as hamlet expansion and water/sewer expansion have geotechnical and other details; opportunities also for adding moderate intensity or other classification changes
- significant developments developers have to pick up infrastructure change, but few developers want to work inside the blue line
  - -- example of Westport and North Elba hamlet expansions
- -- after hurricane Irene county was considering request to do expansion for Ausable Forks; opportunity to recover that analysis (Matt S)
- need to consider how to work with Black Brook and Wilmington; part of 'leveraging resources'

## 4. Other summer engagements

- town newsletter opportunity for each working group/town committee to address what they want... or can put material in CPSB draft, looking for inputs
- -- no limit on what we can put in newsletter
- -- goal of getting distributed by 4 July; like inputs in two weeks; Matt S will do final edits
- how do we reach audiences we haven't been reaching?
  - -- more different ways to reach out; visit other events
  - -- if we can get survey done in next couple weeks, then link to newsletter
- do we do a third open house?
  - -- allows quality engagement a survey can't; have to choose venue carefully
- -- group decided not have a third open house this summer because it isn't like to lead to reaching out to other demographics and we've got enough to do this summer

# 5. July 4<sup>th</sup> event

- how do we get best feedback from this event?
- need to have survey before then people can take on paper or cell phone
- how about a kid's table to engage kids, thereby allowing talk with adults? 4 July is a chaotic family event
- could have a map and sticker as in Chesterfield for people to identify locations where they do things and where they'd like to see new opportunities
- could also have a board for people to write things on a card or sticky note
- let's try some different things to see if they'll work; we'll learn things and then can decide what to do in future
- maybe plan a fall open house in Upper Jay; end of September/early October (Matt S)
- -- some concern October will be local election season; possible campaign forum then
- -- want to keep comp plan non-partisan
- -- I think we should be away from entire political cycle; may get different town board (Wally W)

- -- September 6<sup>th</sup> is sustainability and energy session
- we'll have more data in August along with 4 July/Jay Day results; have more substance later in the fall
- importance of keeping survey simple and short (example of survey #1)
- we'll have ideas more than a plan for 4 July; so we'll have to do some planning on-line
- we'll also refine the survey on-line using email and by Zoom
- summer: get workshop result out; get survey out; have tables at events; possibly touch base with events such as fire district commissioner meetings
- discussion of some logistics for 4 July; stickers, boards, maps, tables, tent, QR code for survey
